Thank you for your reply; however, I have a few questions.

1. According to the Ontario Crown Liability and Proceedings Act:

- a. S. 15 states that: "A document to be served personally on the Crown in a proceeding to which it is a party shall be served by leaving a copy of the document with an employee of the Crown at the Crown Law Office (Civil Law) of the Ministry of the Attorney General."
- b. S. 18(1) states that "No proceeding that includes a claim for damages may be brought against the Crown unless, at least 60 days before the commencement of the proceeding, the claimant serves on the Crown, in accordance with section 15, notice of the claim containing sufficient particulars to identify the occasion out of which the claim arose."
- c. S. 18 (2) states that "The Attorney General may require such additional particulars as in "his or her opinion" are necessary to enable the claim to be investigated."
- d. S. 18 (4) states that "Despite subsection (1), no proceeding that includes a claim for damages may be brought against the Crown under clause 8 (1) (b) unless the notice required by subsection (1) is served on the Crown in accordance with section 15 no later than 10 days after the occurrence of the event out of which the claim arises."
- 2. I first began "giving notice" to MAG over two years ago during convid when personal service was waived: see evidence and acknowledgement (& games played by MAG admin) at attachments #1 and #2. As far as I am aware, MAG requires at least 60-days notice ... there is no cap. Ergo, over 700 days of your being aware of MAG's tort and crimes should be sufficient.
- 3. Regarding the scandalous "not later than 10 days after the occurrence of the event....", your crew keeps re-setting that clock (that coyly circumvents the Statute of Limitations https://www.canlii.org/en/on/laws/stat/so-2002-c-24-sch-b/latest/so-2002-c-24-sch-b.html as your taxpayer-funded, career criminals run rampant. See attachment #3 (or view it online). As "the event" is 1,539-days-and-counting in duration, the "after" date has yet to be

Dear Ms. Moore,

We acknowledge receipt of your email of October 19, 2023 (seen below for convenience).

Please note the provisions of the *Crown Liability and Proceedings Act, 2019* ("CLPA").

Section 18(1) of the *CLPA* requires that you serve notice on the Crown at least 60 days <u>before</u> a Claim is issued. The courts have held that failure to give 60 days' notice renders the Claim a nullity. We are therefore not able to waive or abridge the notice requirement.

Please note that pursuant to s. 15 of the *CLPA*, a party must personally serve <u>a</u> document on the Crown by leaving a copy at Crown Law Office (Civil Law). Documents can be served on the Crown or the Attorney General by email or in person.
