The Parties

FOR ORAL REASONS GIVEN

THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

- On a without prejudice/temporary basis, the father shall pay monthly child support to the wife 1. for the 2 children of the marriage in the amount of \$1,924. This is based on the father's "other taxable income" of \$137,000 and the mother's "other taxable income" of \$50,000 + imputed employment income of \$30,000 (for a total of \$80,000).
- The parties are both in receipt of dividend income ("other taxable income") from their joint company. The nature and tax treatment of those dividends is unknown to me as I do not have

the parties' Income Tax Returns before me. Should those show that proper identification of that income in the support calculation would materially affect the outcome, the matter may be brought back before me based on relevant evidence.

- 2. The parties shall share the children's Section 7 expenses: 60% for the father and 40% for the mother.
- 3. The mother is given leave to bring a motion for the sale of the matrimonial home, but only after the Office of the Children's Lawyer has made its recommendations known.
- 4. On a without prejudice basis, the mother's claim for temporary spousal support is denied.
- 5. On the issue of costs, and in light of the father's offer to settle, which was more beneficial to the mother than the result achieved in this motion, I find that the father is entitled to \$2,000 in costs. The outcome, however, might very well be different when the nature/tax treatment of the dividends is known. Therefore, I will give the parties, or either one of them, 30 days whitin which to submit to me, if they wish, further written submissions not exceeding 2 pages, in addition to brief affidavits providing me with the additional evidence confirming the nature/tax treatment of the dividends, and I will then make a final decision on the issue of temporary support. My decision regarding costs may vary depending on the. If no additional submissions are provided to me within 30 days, my cost award will stand and it shall be repaid by the mother at the rate of \$200/month.
