Dear Ms. Martha Mumbach,

re: Initiation of “lawfare” when corporate mismanagement identified

On June 9, 2025, I received an e-mail from law firm Hutcheson Affronti Deisinger that alleged I had served on your organization some Notice of Action. As evidenced on my whistle-blowing site at <https://twb.rocks/blank-00/living/safety/ecmcc/thomas-quatroche>, I did no such thing. Via my nine-page letter that referenced 28 exhibits:

- I *further* evidenced for your CEO Thomas Quatroche the degree of incompetence, negligence and criminality that had infiltrated ECMCC’s Zone 5-2,
- I asked that the guilty parties be (at a minimum) purged from ECMCC operations,
- I requested compensation for my investigation that amassed the damning evidence (as well as deletion of the invoice that resulted from the illegal six-week detention of me) and
- I offered my assistance so that ECMCC’s human resources management could improve.

I am a whistleblower, Ms. Mumbach. I am also a mental health advocate who’s been investigating your industry for over a decade. Hospital oversight and accountability is an issue that I take *very* seriously; and, if your organization does not then that is a fact of which both the permanent residents of Buffalo and the students of the University of Buffalo should be aware.

I notified Mr. Hutcheson et al. of the error made (see 20250610 11:20 e-mail enclosed) and requested that they vacate their attempted initiation of some “lawfare” intimidation tactic. Kindly ask whoever at ECMCC misinterpreted my original, 20250521 evidence-laden package as something other than my attempt to be “part of the solution”: an accolade one would think a so-called “teaching hospital” would want.
