1	Mark 9:14-29	<p>14And when he came to <i>his</i> disciples, he saw a great multitude about them, and the scribes questioning with them. 15And straightway all the people, when they beheld him, were greatly amazed, and running to <i>him</i> saluted him. 16And he asked the scribes, What question ye with them? 17And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit; 18And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not. 19He answereth him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him unto me. 20And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming. 21And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child. 22And oftentimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us. 23Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things <i>are</i> possible to him that believeth. 24And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief. 25When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, <i>Thou</i> dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him. 26And <i>the spirit</i> cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead. 27But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose. 28And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out? 29And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting</p> <p>King James Version (Note 9:24 is a sub-optimal translation)</p>
2	Matthew 17:14-21	<p>14And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a <i>certain</i> man, kneeling down to him, and saying, 15Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for oftentimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water. 16And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him. 17Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me. 18And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.</p> <p>19Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out? 20And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. 21Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.</p> <p>King James Version</p>

3	Luke 9:37-42	<p>37The next day, when they had come down from the mountain, a large crowd met Jesus. 38A man in the crowd shouted, "Teacher, I beg you to look at my son. He's my only child. 39Whenever a spirit takes control of him, he shrieks, goes into convulsions, and foams at the mouth. After a struggle, the spirit goes away, leaving the child worn out. 40I begged your disciples to force the spirit out of him, but they couldn't do it." 41Jesus answered, "You unbelieving and corrupt generation! How long must I be with you and put up with you? Bring your son here!" 42While he was coming [to Jesus], the demon knocked the boy to the ground and threw him into convulsions. <u>Jesus ordered the evil spirit to leave.</u> He cured the boy and gave him back to his father.</p> <p>God's Word Translation</p> <p>This version was selected as most other bibles state that Jesus “rebuked” the demon and this is a sub-optimal interpretation. Once we learn the demon's name through prayer and fasting (see Mark 9:29, Matthew 17:21), it must be cast out properly; else, it will simply go into hiding (eg. In a domestic violence shelter, a psychiatric ward, a prison).</p>
4	Matthew 12:43-45 ** risk of casting out demons without a solid plan in place **	<p>43"When an evil spirit comes out of a person, it goes through dry places looking for a place to rest. But it doesn't find any. 44Then it says, 'I'll go back to the home I left.' When it arrives, it finds the house unoccupied, swept clean, and in order. 45Then it goes and brings along seven other spirits more evil than itself. They enter and take up permanent residence there. In the end the condition of that person is worse than it was before. That is what will happen to the evil people of this day."</p> <p>God's Word Translation</p>
