approved. In the interim, please advise on when I am **legally** permitted to seek employment and/or contract revenue in the United States? Also, are there benefits or financial assistance programs that I am entitled to apply to in order to receive some type of financial relief?

I have attempted to communicate with my husband's accomplices in order to receive some of the hundreds of thousands (if not millions) of dollars that he owes me while he remains in my [stolen] property depriving me of legislated financial support (see partial testimony and evidence linked to https://twb.rocks/about-us/sean-kiska_cate-kiska_children-of-deirdre-moore); however, none of them are willing to respond. Criminals do not like to be exposed.
